

## 8<sup>th</sup> notes

8<sup>th</sup> notes (also called quavers) are worth half a quarter note beat each. This means you can clap or play two 8<sup>th</sup> notes for every beat.

A way to count this is to say the beats **1**, **2**, **3**, **4** and add in the 8<sup>th</sup> notes between each beat.



Have a go at playing these example rhythms. Try slowly at first, then build up to faster tempos.
