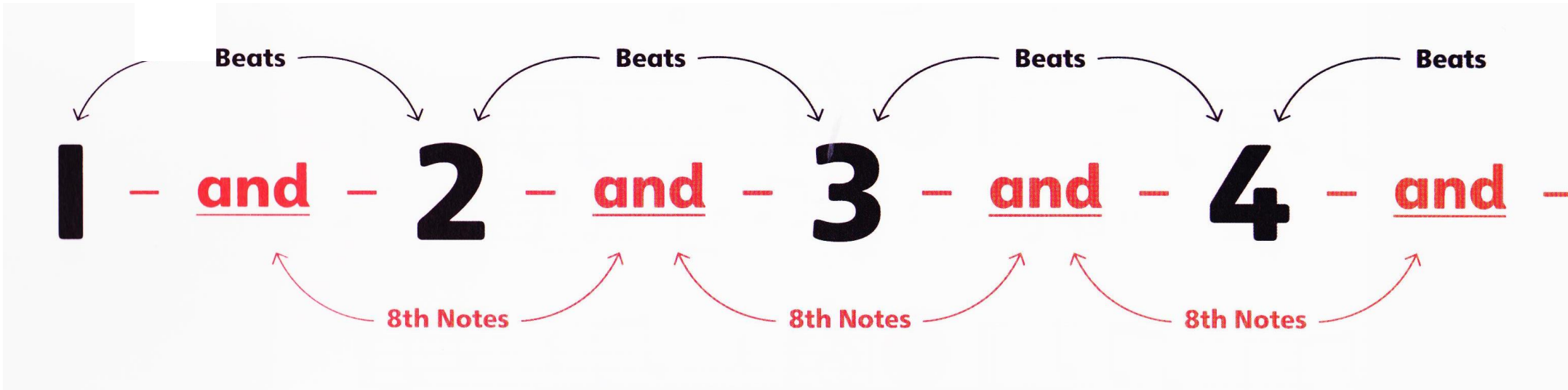


8th notes

Silver stage

8th notes (also called quavers) are worth half a quarter note beat each. This means you can clap or play two 8th notes for every beat.

A way to count this is to say the beats **1, 2, 3, 4** and add in the 8th notes between each beat.



It looks like this in when it's written on the staff.



An 8th note rest is represented on the staff with this symbol.



Have a go at playing these example rhythms.
Try slowly at first, then build up to faster tempos.
